“Mission Trip To Budapest, Hungary 2009”

On Thursday, February 5th, I will leave for a mission trip to Budapest, Hungary. This will be my eighth trip to work in Budapest. I will return on Monday, February 23rd. The time in the air will be just over 12 hours, counting lay-overs for connecting flights it will take about 21 hours to arrive.

I first started working with Curry Montague and the brethren there in 1999. The work in Budapest was started in 1991. Curry is a Tennessee native, and his wife Dora is a native of Hungary. They are blessed with three wonderful boys, (Christian, Mark and Atila). Not long after Christian was born they had to move back to the states due to his medical problems. This caused the church in Budapest to suffer. Curry started making several trips each year to keep the work going.

With the medical field advancing in Budapest the Montague's were recently able to move back on a full time basis. This will be a tremendous help to the work.

I will be preaching a gospel meeting while there, and doing personal Bible studies.
One thing I always try and accomplish is to

encourage the brethren. This is the only faithful congregation in a city of two million people, and as in any congregation, brethren need to be uplifted. I have been blessed to be able to do mission work in other countries, and if God allows me there are some other works I would like to be involved with in the future. But one of the benefits of going back to the same work several times is you get to know the brethren of that congregation well, and can have a continual part in their spiritual lives. It is encouraging to them to know someone cares enough to come back again.

We will also travel to the city of Debrecen to preach the gospel there. This congregation just started in 2005. This is the only faithful congregation in this city. It is not as big as Budapest, but it is a very beautiful place. I am thankful to our heavenly Father for blessing me with the opportunity to have a small part in these good works.

If you would like to assist me with the expense of this trip it would be very helpful and greatly appreciated. "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen" (I Thess. 5:28).
